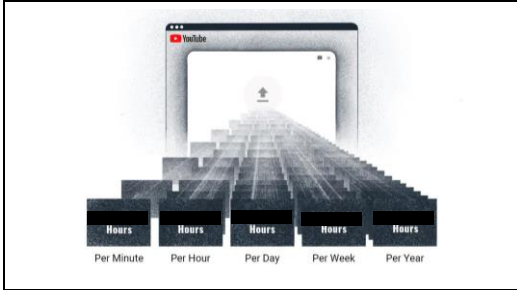
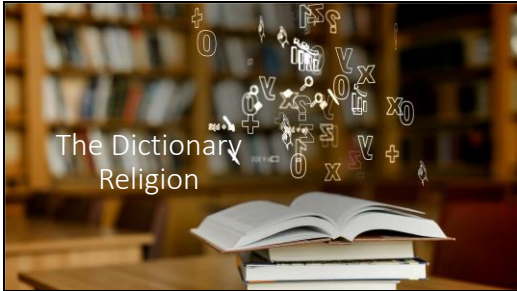

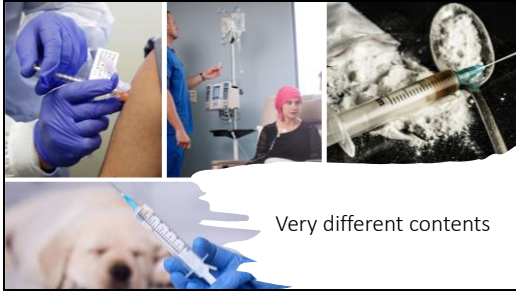
Religion

UNCONTROLLABLE

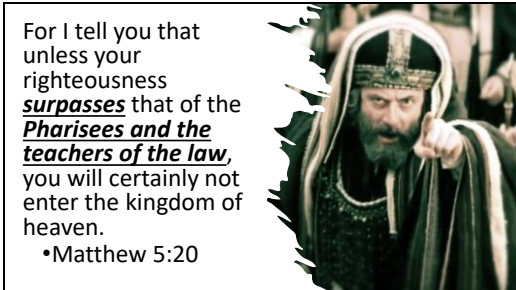


Religion is 2 kinds of people trying to do the same thing. Sort of like syringes.

Both religious and Jesus followers doing the same things but with very different motives.

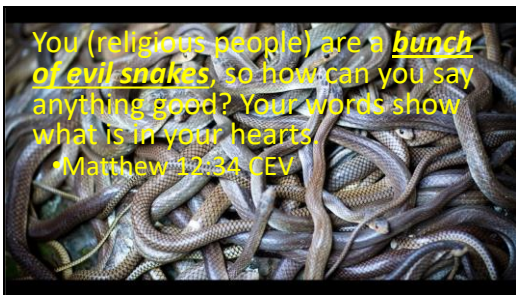


- Trees

Not exactly gentle Jesus meek and mild.

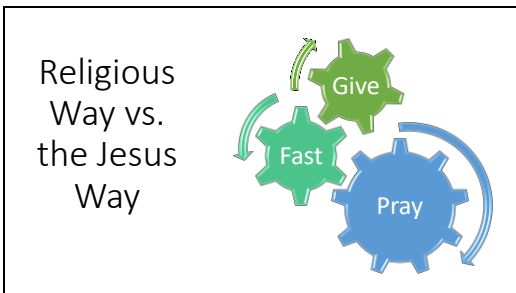


Smug

Giving – to impress people or done in secret for eternal perspective.





Turn the other cheek – reconnect and reestablish loving relationship again.

pray for those who persecute you – where do you pray? Alone.

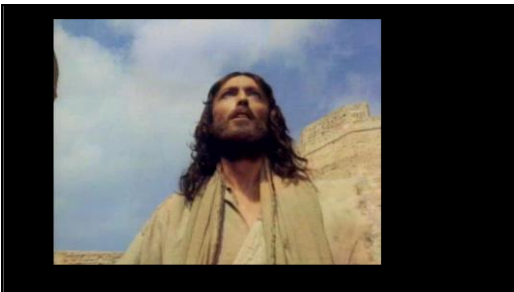

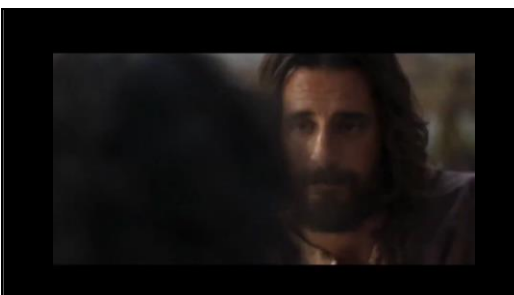

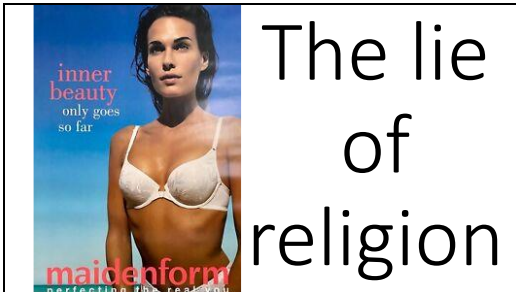
He's a Father and not a Boss – obey God out of loving relationship.

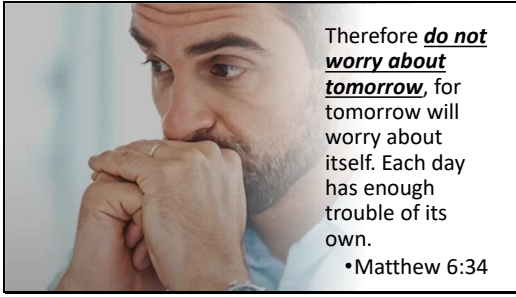
