




Shocked





2. build each other up – on an individual basis







But to each one of us **grace** has been given **as Christ apportioned it.** This is why it says: “When he ascended on high, he took many captives and gave gifts to his people.”


grace – spiritual gifts

 So, when God uses certain words, it's important and we need to pay attention.






Gifts – Motivations

Motivation-How God works in a believer to shape their perspective on life, motivating their words and actions
 Ministry-How God works through a believer in a given situation to demonstrate His supernatural power
 Manifestation-How God works with what a believer does to serve and meet the needs of others


