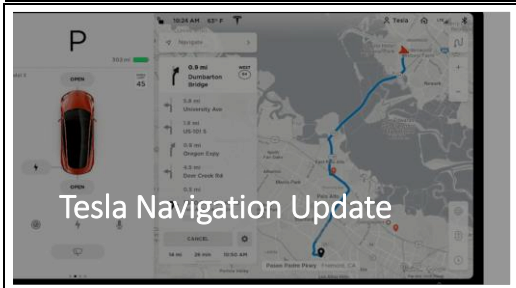

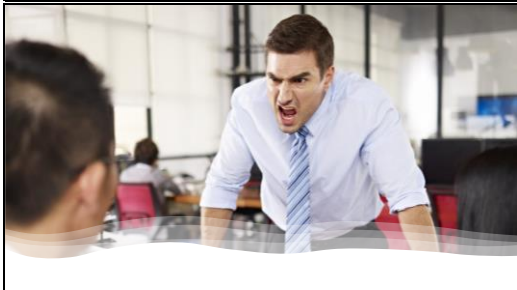
Apology – this has been used as a club to beat up people.

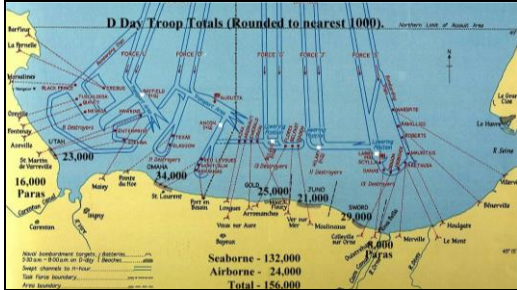
Today, the idea of submitting is seen as a violation of our human rights and dignity.



Submit is a military meaning, to be organized and to take your place, doing your job/duty, used of both troops. Roman soldiers and formation – submitting to leaders and one another for protection and strength



Submit is a military meaning, to be organized and to take your place, doing your job/duty, used of both troops or ships, soldiers arranged in military order under a commanding officer, the placing of one individual under or to another.



D-Day plan – almost 7,000 seagoing vessels, over 3,000 aircraft and gliders, and over 156,000 troops. Everyone had a role to play, a beach to attack. There was a plan, and everyone had to submit to it, stay on target, stay in their lane, do their duty, win their battle.

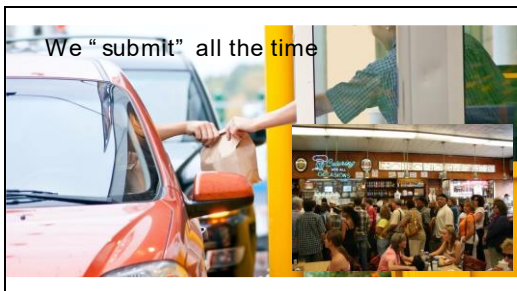
Theodore Roosevelt Jr was part of that landing, he was the only general on D-Day to land by sea with the first wave of troops. At 56, he was the oldest man in the invasion, and the only one whose son also landed that day; they were among the first wave of soldiers at Omaha Beach, but there was a problem.



They were about a mile from the planned landing area, but they couldn't stop, they had to keep on going and have the second wave of people and equipment follow them.



Dan Sickles moved his III Corps without orders to an untenable position, where they suffered 40% casualties. Sickles himself was wounded by cannon fire and had to have his leg amputated. It left Little Round Top totally undefended. The Confederacy could have easily defended and shelled much of the Union's positions.

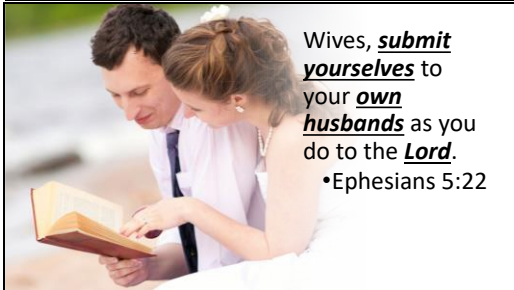

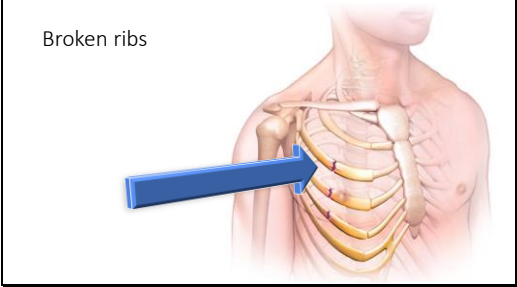
assurance – proof, tested, proving the reality of the invisible.

One rib alone can’t do much of anything, but together they can protect and flex.



What makes broken ribs painful? Your ribs move when you breathe, cough, and move your upper body. Rib fractures often occur with other chest and organ injuries.

What makes broken ribs dangerous? Upper rib fractures can cause injuries to the large vessels that bring blood to and from the heart. It's not uncommon for a fractured rib to cause injury to the lung itself, sometimes leading to a collapsed lung or bleeding into the chest cavity. Lower rib fractures can cause injuries to the liver and spleen.
