






Total household debt rose \$312 billion, or 2 percent, in the second quarter of 2022 to reach \$16.15 billion, according to the latest Quarterly Report on Household Debt and Credit. Mortgage balances—the largest component of household debt—climbed \$207 billion and stood at \$11.39 trillion as of June 30. Credit card balances saw their largest year-over-year percentage increase in more than twenty years, while aggregate limits on cards marked their largest increase in over ten years.






In Ephesus, there is an important Christian symbol; sometimes referred to as the "Christian wheel" which is believed to precede the symbol of the fish. Variations of it can be found in several locations throughout Ephesus. It consists of the ancient Greek letters, IXOYE, which spell the word "Ichthys", which was the word for "fish" and it spells out Jesus Christ God's Son Savior.

I – first letter of the name Jesus in the Greek alphabet.

X – first letter in the Greek word for Anointed One, Messiah, or "Christ"


O – first letter for the Greek term for God.

E – first letter in the Greek word for “Savior”

happiness!'


